1. Data Controller

2. Purpose and Scope of Processing

3. Legal Basis for Processing

Processing takes place on the basis of the **legitimate interest of the controller** (Art. 6 para. 1 lit. f) GDPR) - specifically, the interest in responding to requests and inquiries submitted through the website.

4. Retention Period

Data from the contact form is stored for as long as necessary to respond to the inquiry, but for no longer than 2 years from the last communication. After that, the data is irrevocably deleted.

5. Recipients of Data

Personal data is not disclosed to third parties except for the hosting provider and email services, who are contractually obliged to protect the data. Data is not transferred outside the EU/EEA.

6. Your Rights

As a data subject, you have the right to access your data, rectify it, erase it, restrict processing, data portability and the right to object to processing. You can exercise your rights by e-mail to sophie.kemp@syntaxory.com.

7. Security

The controller takes appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data, in particular data transmission encryption (HTTPS) and restricted access to data.
